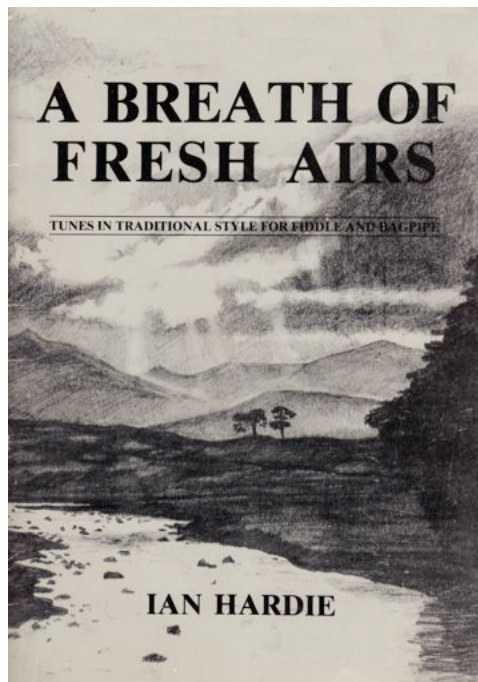

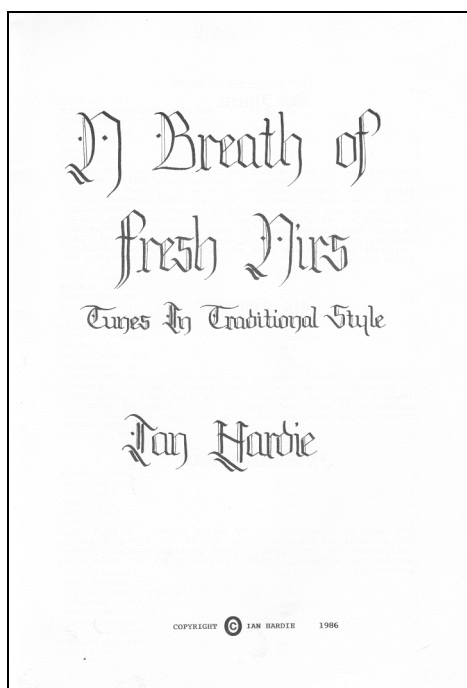
There are three books in this series. A fourth by book Hardie, The Nineties Collection, is not considered part of this series. It is included in this *Bibliography* as a separate book.

p [i], title; p [ii], The Music, The Composer and Acknowledgements; p [iii], contents; pp 1-32; tunes (54).

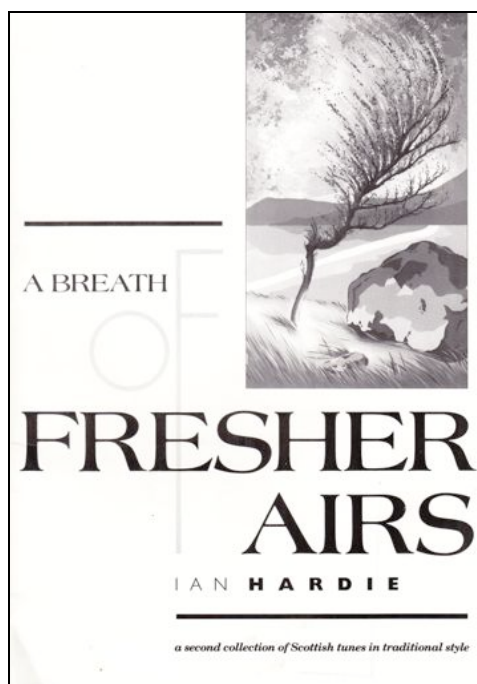

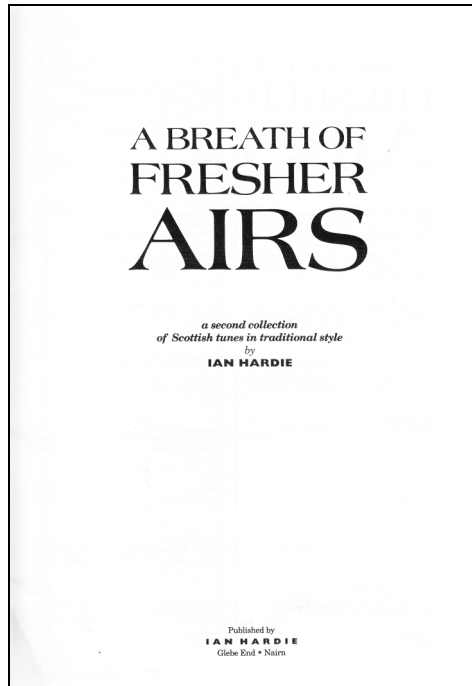
An advertisement appeared in the *Piping Times* Vol 39, No 5, February 1987 advises this book was 'Just published'.

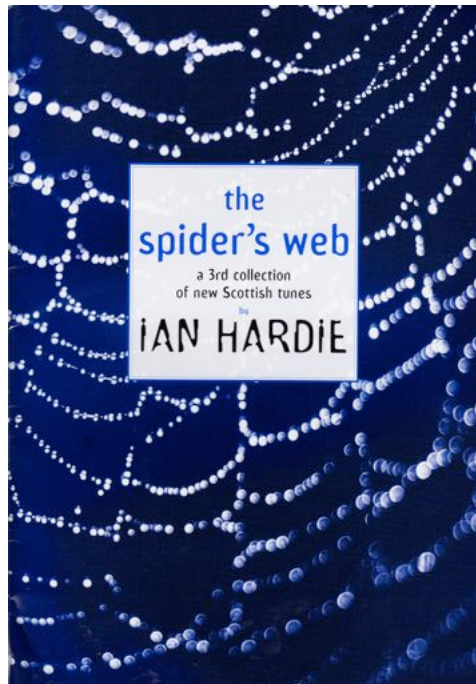
p [i], title; p [1], foreword and contents; p 2-35, tunes (56).

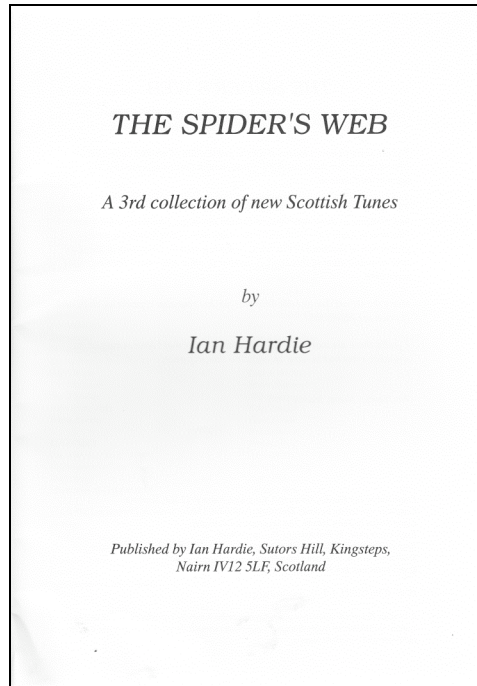
This book differs from Book 1 in that the music has been type set and the tunes are not arranged in two different sections.
