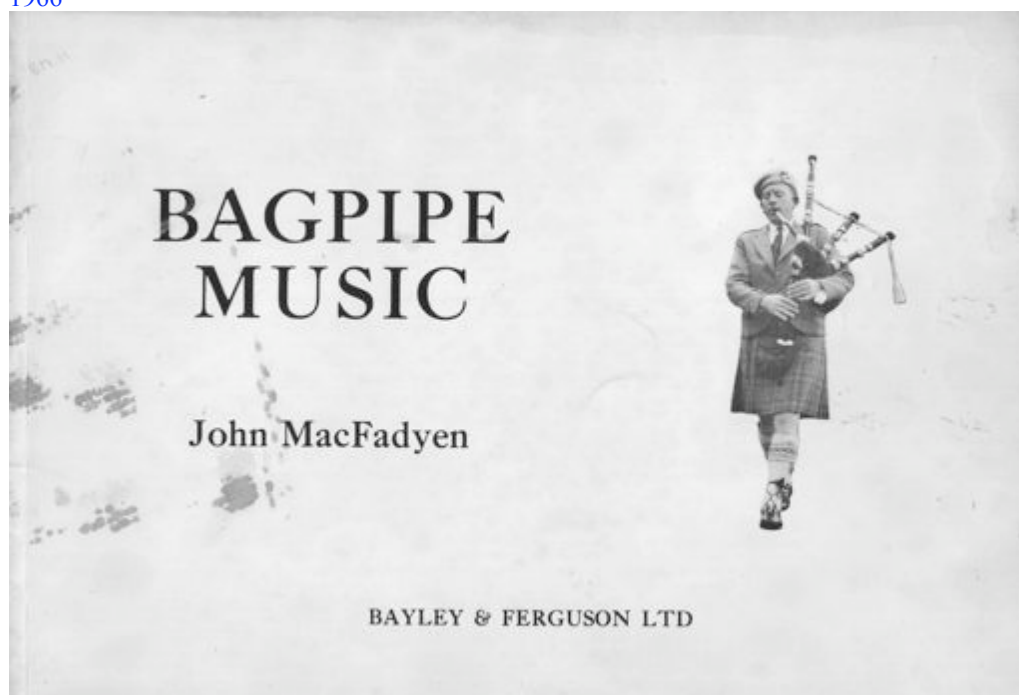
389 Bagpipe Music by John MacFadyen

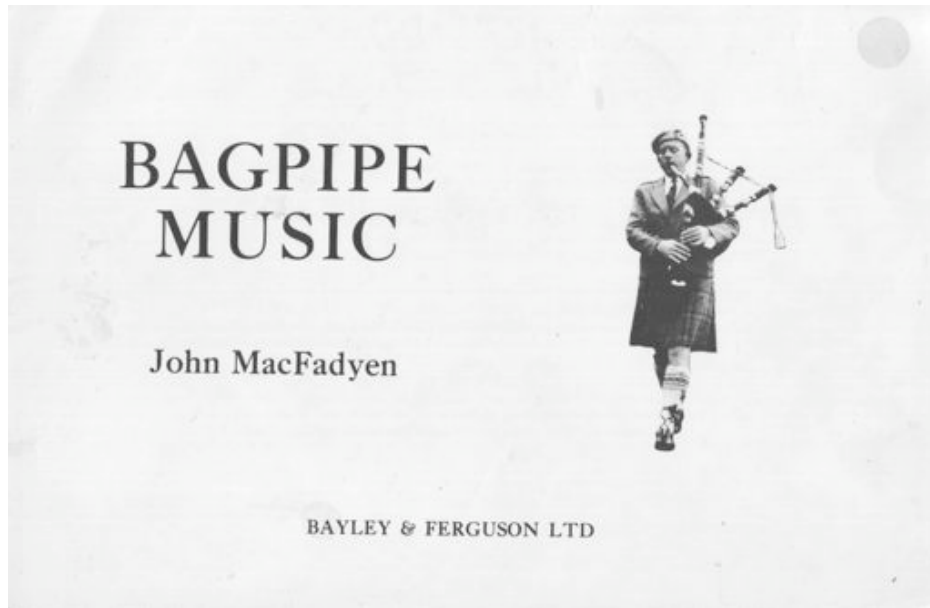

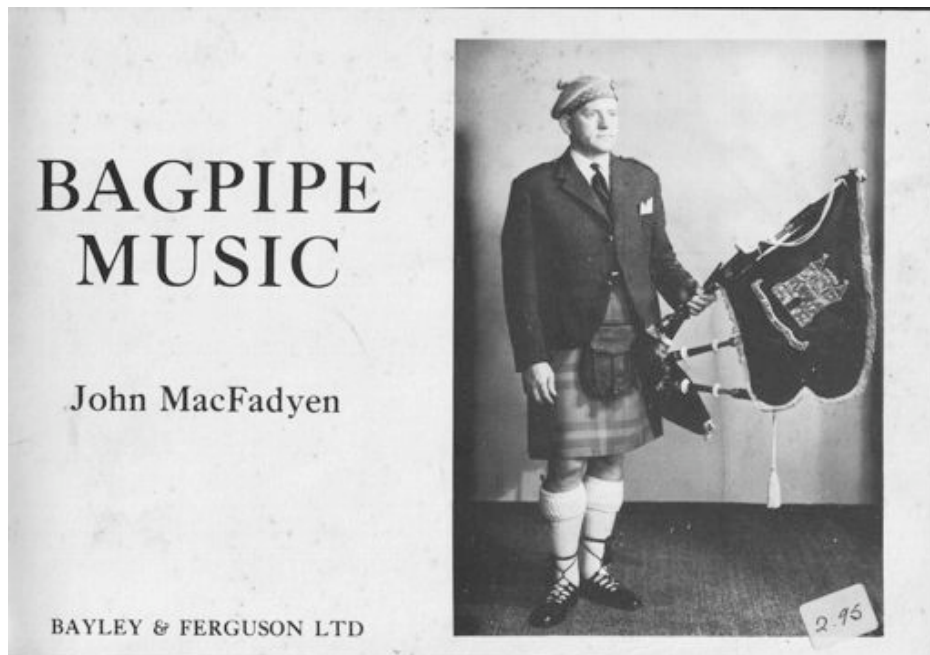
